NETWORK MANAGER

DEFINITION

Under general supervision of the Director of Information Technology; designs, engineers, installs, programs, maintains, and provides training for District <u>Wide Area Network</u> and site <u>Local Area Network</u> hardware and software ensuring availability, usability, and expandability of network services. Perform other duties as assigned.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Install, test and evaluate new hardware and software applications;

Diagnose network and computer problems and recommend and/or implement solutions;

Update or upgrade network hardware and software as necessary; represent the District to vendors;

Assist in implementation of Local Area Networks and Wide Area Network hardware and software;

Assist in preparing operations manuals;

Install, configure, and maintain equipment such as routers, switches, hubs, servers, CPUs, printers, and peripheral devices; install District-support software and data security systems;

Set up and maintain server/work-station networks; administer networks; perform network configurations Provide technical assistance and guidance to data security system users;

Train administrators and staff in proper use of data security equipment and systems;

Maintain network components to minimize network downtime in the event of component failure;

Assist in seeking and developing grants for funding District technology;

Work with telecom companies and other service providers to minimize downtime and optimize network performance;

Supervise and train District and site technical personnel as needed.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Mostly indoor work environment, some outdoor work to access needed areas to complete networking cabling, hardware installation/configuration, etc., and drive a vehicle to conduct work.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Use of hands and fingers to operate a computer keyboard and related equipment; Hearing and speaking to exchange information; Reaching overhead, above the shoulders and horizontally; Bending at the waist; kneeling or crouching to install equipment; Ability to work in confined areas if needed to complete networking cabling; Carrying, pushing or pulling equipment up to 100 pounds; Lifting or moving moderately heavy equipment up to 50 pounds; Seeing to distinguish colors and to view computer monitors; Sitting and operating a keyboard to enter data into a computer terminal for extended periods of time.

HAZARDS

Exposure to electrical power supply, high voltage and hazardous chemicals; and extended viewing of a computer monitor.

REQUIRED LICENSES AND/OR CERTIFICATES

Possession of a valid California Driver's License and maintain possession of such license during the course of employment; have an acceptable driving record; and must be insurable at standard rates by District's insurance carrier and maintain such insurability during the course of employment.
