### Measure T Projects and School Construction Status Report Report as of July 18, 2013

- 1. Hemet High School (Measure T)
  - a. Phase 3 Exterior Portable Removal and Parking Lot(Trittipo Architects)
    - i. Phase III is pending replacement of Architect.
    - ii. Phase I and II are pending phase III close out.
- 2. Whittier Costs have been analyzed and project has been placed on the Measure T list.
- 3. Santa Fe site –. Staff is working on closing out Life Skills project with DSA.
- **4.** <u>Ramona</u> preschool received grant for shade structure. Grant just short of paying for entire project. Remaining funds from measure T. Project was completed over the summer and staff is working on achieving DSA closeout.
- **5.** <u>Acacia</u> Project began over Christmas Break with Balfour Beatty mobilizing and installing temporary fence. First phase to be complete by end of summer.
  - **a.** <u>GYM</u> Concrete slab is poured. Walls are framed and have plywood installed. Utilities are roughed in. Steel beams in main gym have been installed. Interior framing and sheeting are ongoing.
  - **b.** <u>Portables</u> 700 and 800 portables have been placed. Concrete walkways are poured. Furniture is moved back in. Painting is ongoing. Low voltage is being installed. 100 portables are being placed. Interiors have been remodeled. Utilities are scheduled for installation.
  - **c. Detention System** Underground detention system is installed and covered.
  - **d.** <u>Site Utilites</u> Water, storm drain and sewer have been installed across the campus. Gas line is moving with phasing (currently to 500/600 buildings). Electrical and low voltage conduits have been replaced and upgraded. Cabling pending the completion of the MDF room. Street improvements have been installed and approved by the City. Communication to cell tower has been relocated. Overhead lines and excess power poles/switchgear have been removed. Irrigation main line is installed from street to booster pump.
  - e. <u>North Parking Lot</u> Parking lot is paved. Solar panel columns and beams have been installed. Irrigation laterals have been installed.
  - **f.** South Block Wall South block wall has been installed and back filled. Electrical and low voltage cabinets/pathways are installed for the 700 and 800 portables. Irrigation laterals are installed.
  - g. <u>500/600 Building</u> Abatement has been completed. Interior demolition has begun.
  - **h.** <u>Basketball Court</u> Overex and compaction has been completed. Base has been installed. Basketball poles have been installed. Ball wall foundations have been installed. Paving to commence next week.
  - **i.** <u>Administration</u> Administration staff has been moved to portables. Administration building is pending abatement and demolition.
- **6.** <u>Idyllwild</u> Contractor has closed doors. Ramp is complete. Railing is in process. Staff is working with Bonding Company to complete project.
