I. PRELIMINARY

- A. Call to Order
- B. Roll Call & Establishment of Quorum

 Mrs. Dalbey called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m., indicating that a quorum was established.
- C. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>
 On a motion by Mr. Schembri, seconded by Mr. Green, the agenda for the meeting was approved.
- D. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>
 On a motion by Mr. Shabashov, seconded by Mr. Excell, the minutes for the February 1, 2007 meeting were unanimously approved.

- III. <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u> None

IV. SPECIAL ITEMS

A. Bond Issuance

Mr. Beck reviewed the Official Statement for the Series A \$60 million dollar General Obligation Bond stating we received an "A" rating from Standard & Poor's at an effective rate of 4.369%. The bonds were sold on March 1, 2007 and the funds were received on March 14, 2007.

B. Analysis for Costs of Testing and Inspection Services

Due to questions regarding the cost of testing and inspection services, Bill Downing of douglas e. barnhart reviewed the requirements and expenses and explained that the Division of State Architects (DSA) requires that a licensed DSA Inspector provide continuous inspection on particular construction projects within a school district. Ms. Koonce stated the cost is usually under 1% of the project. Our inspectors only call out services when needed. Vendor charges by the hour.

C. Review of Rancho Viejo Middle School Bid

Ms. Koonce reviewed the budget stating there was a tremendous response to the bid opening. The low bid for the contract came in at \$24.2 million, significantly lower than the expected \$30 million. Mr. Excell asked if there was a risk of the cost rising due to materials and Bill Downing stated the construction contract cost was locked in. All our contracts are locked in.

D. Review of Tahquitz High School Phase II Bid

Ms. Koonce reviewed the budget stating Phase II consisted of the swimming pool, two buildings with 32 classrooms, lower play field, four tennis courts, shop classroom, lunch kiosk and shelters, and two parking lots. Ms. Koonce stated Phase II would be completed for the beginning of the 2008-09 school year.

E. Measure T Funding and Project Plan Update

Ms. Koonce stated the third meeting had been held for the Hemet High School Expansion with a site walk discussing traffic flow and electric issues. She further explained the Environmental Impact Report for Page Ranch Elementary School was complete and ready for Board approval in May. Currie Ranch Elementary School is waiting for California Department of Education (CDE) site approval in order to begin the purchase agreement with the property owners.

F. Measure T Financial Report

Ms. Brightman stated that the District had expended \$1,586,335.53 of the \$60,413,400.00 we received as of April 3, 2007. She explained that within the financial report there were two pages for each site. The first page contained the Bond language as it appeared on the ballot, a list of the funding sources for that site and the Measure T budget. The second page had a listing of the purchase orders and contracts and showed how much had been paid on them. She stated that the contract amounts could change if there are change orders.

G. Deferred Maintenance Funds

Mr. Beck reviewed the Deferred Maintenance projects stating we were making maximum use of the funds available. He explained the District is required to set aside 2% of their General Fund for maintenance and the State matches up to 1/2% of these funds. He explained that carpet, roofing and painting were ongoing projects and we were working on the high priorities of the list to coincide with Measure T projects.

H. Future Meetings and Membership

Mr. Beck requested the Thursday, June 21, 2007 COC meeting be rescheduled to Wednesday June, 20, 2007. The Committee unanimously approved. Mr. Beck said the Governing Board had interviewed candidates to fill the Committee vacancies at the end of the term in June. He invited all to attend the Ground Breaking Ceremony for Rancho Viejo Middle School on June 8, 2007 at 2:00 p.m.

V. <u>ADJOURNMENT</u>

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.

HEMET UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES DEPARTMENT Measure T Project and School Site Status Report Project Status Report as of June 11, 2007

- Acacia Currently have three conceptual designs from two architects. Staff will present to Governing Board Facilities Committee options for review.
- 2. Bautista Creek Whiteboards will be replaced this summer.
- Cawston ES Four relos are to be moved from West Valley to Cawston over the summer. Contracts have been Board approved and construction to start June 18th.
- 4. <u>Cottonwood School</u> Phase 1 has been approved and construction to start on water tank, pump house and relocatable classroom on June 18th. Staff is bidding out the septic tank for construction. PJHM Architects is working on a design for the library. We are currently obtaining quotes from modular companies for the construction of a modular building. Staff has obtained final CDE site approval and is working on the OPSC funding application.
- 5. <u>Hamilton K-8</u> Relocatable classroom contract has been approved by the Board. Construction to start on June 18th. Scope of work to include, widening the retaining wall to accommodate a larger fire lane, addition of one relocatable classroom, adding fencing near kindergarten classrooms.
- 6. <u>Hamilton High School</u> Fencing contract has been approved by the Board and will start on June18th. The fence will be added to the perimeter of the site, a combination of wrought iron and chain link will be used to secure the site.
- 7. <u>HELP School URS Corporation will assist in preparing a scope of work and will submit a proposal for demolition of building. Staff is working with Hemet High School Grad Night to find an adequate location to store the equipment.</u>
- 78. Hemet Elementary Relocatable restroom will be replaced with a newer restroom from Cottonwood Elementary. Staff is also working to demolish the three relocatable classrooms on site.
- 9. Hemet High School
 - a. Classroom construction is near completion. Flooring will be complete in 2 weeks. Interior painting completed. Field house prepped for painting next week. Staff is working on punch list items.
 - b. Therapy Room Staff is preparing scope of work to remodel the exiting room to accommodate SH students.

- c. Staff is preparing scope of work to install foul poles, updated scoreboards at varsity baseball and softball fields.
- d. Remodel meetings are held every Monday at 1:30pm. Work with site administrators on admin remodel, additional classrooms and parking lot remodel. Architects
- 10. Idyllwild K-8 Whiteboards will be installed this summer.

11. Jacob Wiens -

- 12. <u>Little Lake</u> Site Administrator has requested that perimeter fencing be installed along sidewalk. Scope of work is under development, work will be quoted and construction to start this summer.
- 13. <u>Professional Development Academy</u> Project is 85% complete. Staff is scheduled to be moved in starting June 18th.
- 14. <u>Professional Development Service Center</u> Exterior walls completed. Undergrounding complete. Grading is complete on the parking lot. Transportation building has framing and rooking complete. Interior work started.
- 15. <u>Ramona</u> Two relocatable classrooms are to be installed over summer. Work to start June 18th.
- **16.** Rancho Viejo Middle School grading has started. Working on underground utilities.
- 17. <u>Santa Fe</u> Building 700 interior requested to be refurbished to use rooms as weight room and woodshop. Staff is requesting permission to bid out work.

18. Tahquitz High School

- a. Phase 1- Final clean up under way. Gymnasium flooring 50% complete. Staff office furniture delivered. Final punch list items remain.
- Phase 2 Construction on under grounding on two classrooms started.
 Framing of additional lunch shelters underway.
 Waiting to be painted.
- c. <u>Phase 3</u> (stadium) Plans are at DSA waiting for approval. Once DSA approved, project will be bid out. Estimated 12 month construction schedule.
- 19. West Valley High School Staff is moving 4 relos to Cawston ES. The Williams Scottsman rental relos (5) are to be removed this summer. Staff will relocate one relo which will open up the parking drop off by the County building. Work is to be bid along with the Cawston project. Work to start June 18th. PJHM Architects to submit proposal to create master plan to add baseball and softball scoreboards, foul poles, and dugouts and to upgrade track and field. Staff to

- also prepare budget to concreting parking lot islands throughout entire campus. Staff is working with City of Hemet to master plan a solution concerning the traffic flow off campus.
- 20. Whittier –PCH Architects to submit proposal to create master plan to add fire hydrant, two relocatable classrooms, fencing and refurbishment of playfield. Staff is preparing bid doc's to replace or refurbish 100 whiteboards in classrooms.
- 21. <u>Winchester</u> PCH Architects to continue to work on obtaining DSA approval for previous work completed on Administration building. Approvals are needed to obtain current DSA approval to start construction on Administration building.
- 22. Page Ranch Elementary (ES #5, Rancho Diamante) CDE site application package will be submitted shortly thereafter. PJHM Architects to design building, and prepare for DSA approval of plans. Project is part of Measure T monies.
- 23. New ES #6 (Winchester Hills) Right of Entry has been received by owner. Staff is working with consultants to start environmental testing for CDE approval. Process takes approximately 9 months.
- 24. New ES #7 (French Valley) Staff to meet with Tom Tooker to site visit for 4.0 approval. Once CDE allows District to proceed, District will meet with Garret Ranch to prepare Right of Entry documents.
- 25. <u>Gibbel Elementary (ES #8 McSweeny Farms) –</u> Site has been approved by CDE. Barnhart is working on a constructability review to return to PJHM. PJHM Architects is working on DSA comments. Estimated DSA approval date is August 2007.
- 26. Pleasant Valley ES (ES #10 Winchester Ranch) Site has been approved by CDE. Project has not been awarded to a construction manager. PJHM is waiting for DSA approval on Gibbel to "piggyback" plans. Project will be part of CFD and/or developer fees budget.
- 27. Stoney Ridge ES (ES #11 San Jacinto city) Project is low priority. Biological report complete, geotechnical, PEA and CEQA reports in progress. Staff is working with architects on conceptual design; project will be part of CFD and/or developer fees.
- 28. Currie Ranch Elementary (ES #12, Valle Vista Area) A letter has been sent to Riverside County Flood Control to request that the area be included in the County's Five Year Plan. Staff will work with property owners to finalize purchase agreement.

- 29. New ES #15 (Garret Ranch) Right of Way has been sign. Staff is working with developer, City of Hemet and environmental consultants to move project forward. Project is still in specific plan phase at City
- 30. <u>Freedom Middle (MS #2, Rancho Diamante)</u> See Page Ranch ES. Project is not part of Bond Measure T monies. Project will be completed using CFD and or local funding.
- 31. <u>Middle School #5 (Valle Vista)</u> Continuing to work with developer who want more lots and less school site. Architect has created several designs for site, waiting on developers input. PEA, Biological and geotechnical reports complete. Continuing to work on CEQA process.
- 32. <u>Domenigoni Middle School (MS #8 Winchester) –</u> Location was moved from the corner of Olive and Longfellow west to the corner of Olive and Beeler due to an Edison substation that is in design by Edison. The biological report is complete. Geotechnical, PEA and CEQA reports are underway.
- 33. <u>High School #3 (Winchester)</u> Staff is working with developer and County Transportation on the realignment of Hwy 74. If the Hwy is to be located near property, the District will need to seek other site, as it will not be approvable through CDE.
- 34. Interim Elementary/Alternative Education The District has approximately 5 acres adjacent to Cawston Elementary that can be used as interim school or as a future alternative education facility.
